CBR is implemented through the combined efforts of PWDs themselves, their families, organizations and communities, and the governmental and non-governmental health, education, vocational, social and other services. The primary objective of CBR programme activities is the improvement of the quality of life of people with disabilities. How much rehabilitation services and vocational training is important for leading their life towards independence.

One focus of CBR programme activities is working with the community to create positive attitudes towards people with disabilities and to motivate community members to support and participate in CBR activities.

Students provide awareness to the society by distributing flyers of Ashtavakra School and guidance to the parents of the differently abled children. Students of the institute also provided information regarding various schemes of the National Trust and about the Educational Opportunity existing for these special kids to the people.



CBR promotes the rights of PWDs to live as equal citizens within the community, to enjoy health and well being, to participate fully in educational, social, cultural, and religious activities. The other focus of CBR programmes is providing assistance for people with all types of disabilities (physical, sensory, psychological and mental); for people of all ages, for people affected by leprosy; for people affected by epilepsy; and for other people who may be identified by the community as needing special assistance.
