- 3. **NEUROSCIENCES:** Here at spinal injuries centre, facilities featuring neurosurgical procedures ranging from head injuries management to functional neurosurgery.
- 4. **REHABILITATION:** In ISIC, Rehabilitation has two meanings while an important objective is to help the patients in improving his/her physical conditions and promote recovery through adequate treatment.
