Report on CBR Activity

Community Based Rehabilitation Program play an important role for the rehabilitation and management of children and adults with disability. The students of HI Dept identified Najabgarh Village for the activity. Before conducting the activity all the students were briefed about the survey forms to be filled, case history to be taken of the special population identified. The students were divided in groups and were allotted the houses to be covered. The students were able to identify the disabled population. They briefed the parents regarding Govt Schemes, vocational education and other medical facilities available for them. The students created the awareness in the community through the media of posters, banners, plays, local songs etc. The students gave detailed information regarding education and training of disabled and also showed them way for social integration of the disabled at the community level. The parents were also briefed about how to get admission in special schools, facility for training in self help skills, special facilities for education, information related to teaching material and special equipment. The students also gave information regarding community Health Centre, district hospitals, district rehabilitation centers, education through integrated scheme etc

The students also highlighted the concept that by utilizing rehabilitation services they can improve the life of the people. The CBR activity was very fruitful for special need population and students were able to gain practical exposure of dealing with Special need population.
