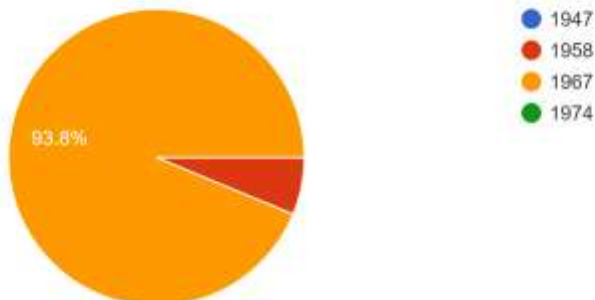

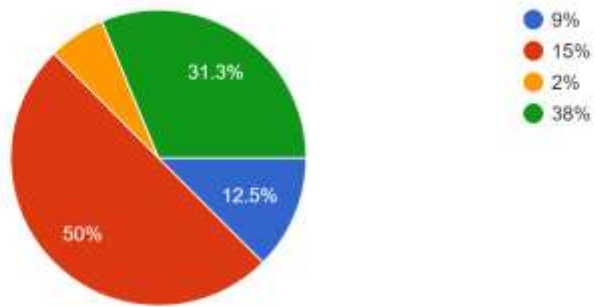

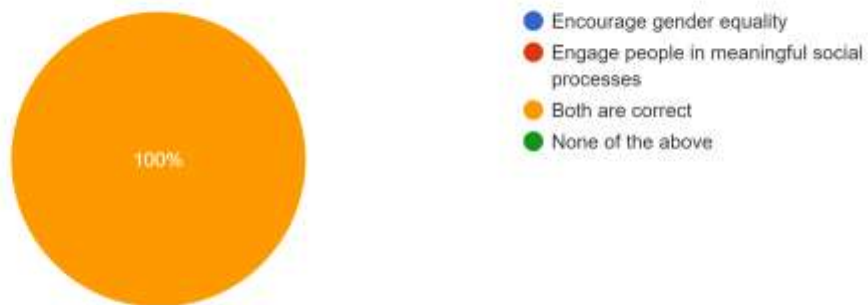

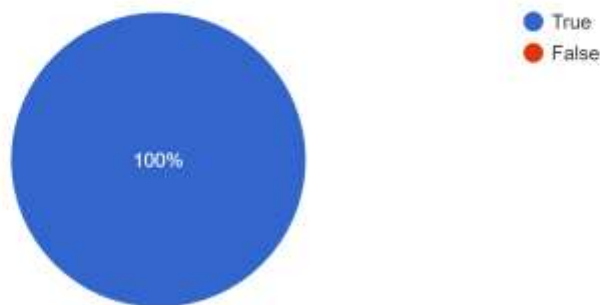

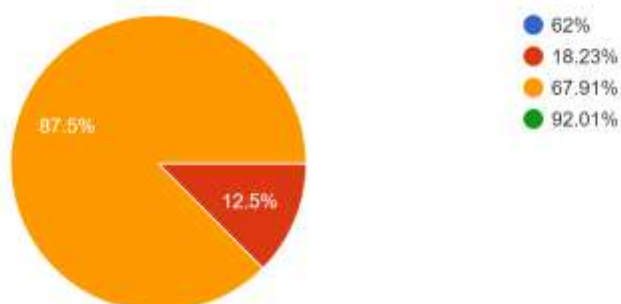

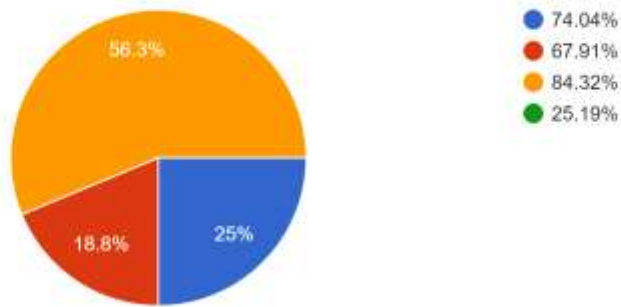
7. Literacy rate of Haryana?

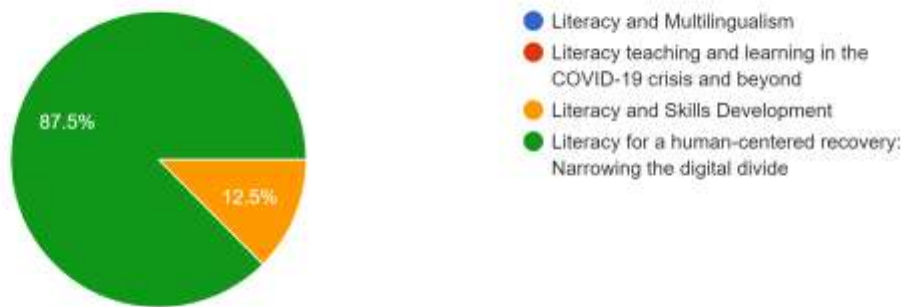

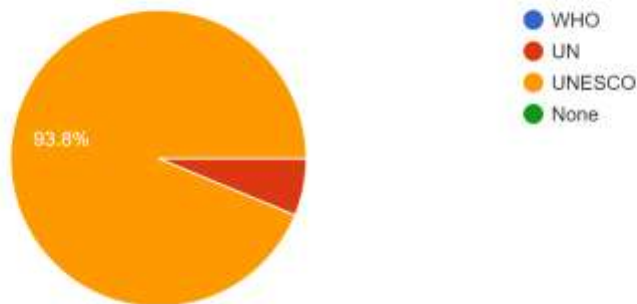

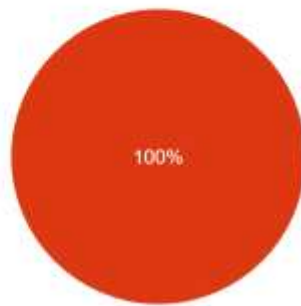

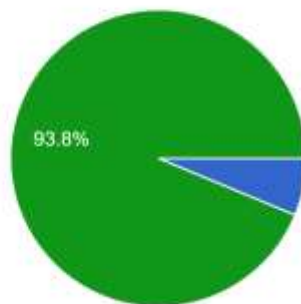

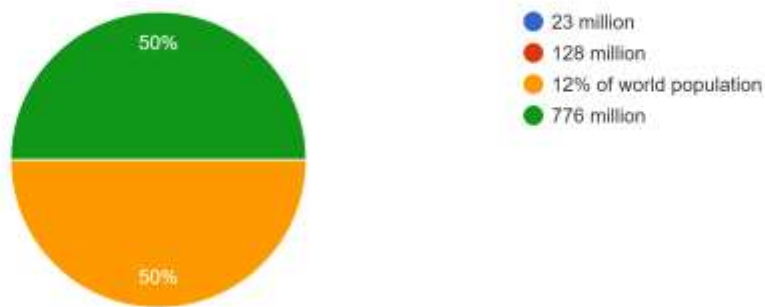

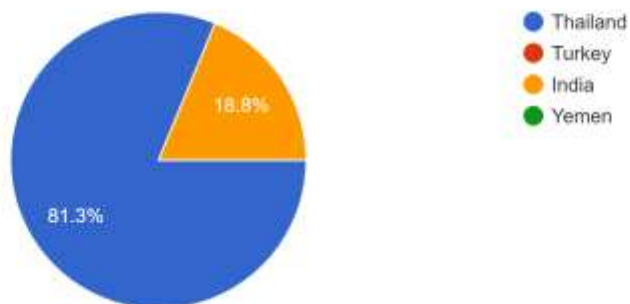
