

#### Report of the Event



The day aims to recognize the right of access to braille by blind people and raise awareness of the importance of braille as a means of communication in the full realization of the human rights for blind and partially sighted people. Braille is a tactile language used by blind and partially sighted people. Combinations of raised dots represent each letter and number, and even musical, mathematical and scientific symbols, so that books and periodicals can be read through touch. The system was invented by Frenchman Louis Braille nearly 200 years ago.

In a post on Twitter, the President of the UN General Assembly, Abdulla Shahid, commended Braille as a tool for freedom of expression, access to information and social inclusion.

Thereafter the Students of the D.Ed.SE.VI and D.Ed.SE.DB one by one express their view about World Braille Day and all the students actively participated in the event. Overall programme was very informative and the event was a great success in this hour of COVID-19 pandemic with the help of Zoom App.











Writing competition presented by all students








## **Braille Reading Competition presented by all students**








