UBA - Village Clean-Up Drive



Under this programme, the B.ed students of ID Department participated in the cleanliness activity under the supervision of mentor Chauhan Priyanka. The cleanliness drive was started from the periphery of the Kanjhawla village. The village Panchayat members actively participated in the drive and thanked AIRSR for initiating this idea. On behalf of Village Panchayat he provided the gloves, garbage collection bags and the masks to the participants in the drive. The entire stretch of Kanjhawla village was cleaned by the students of ID, and all the collected waste (plastic, clothes, cans, bottles, etc.) in the village was handed over to the waste collection vehicle arranged by the MCD.
