UBA – Organic Farming Campaign

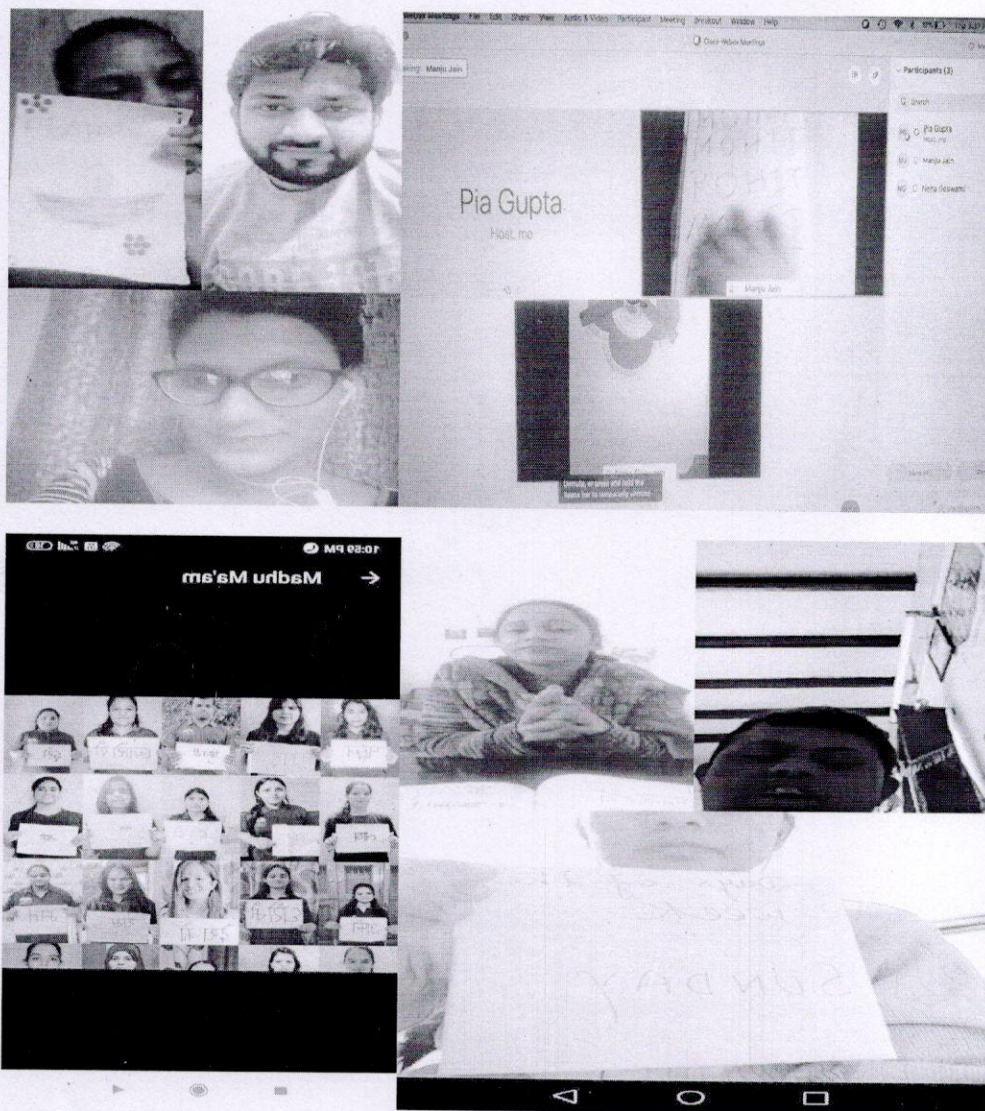

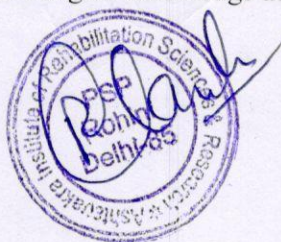
