

Purpose of the Event:

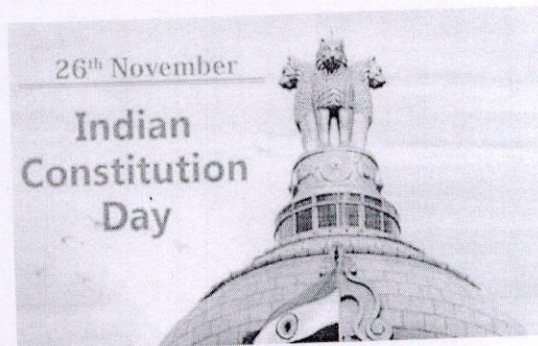

2. The day aims at highlighting the significance of the Indian constitution and to spread thoughts and ideas of BR Ambedkar.

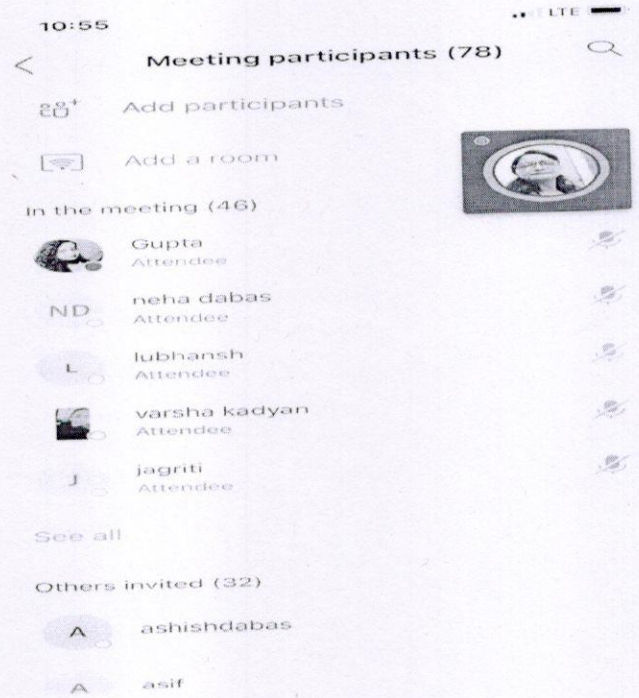
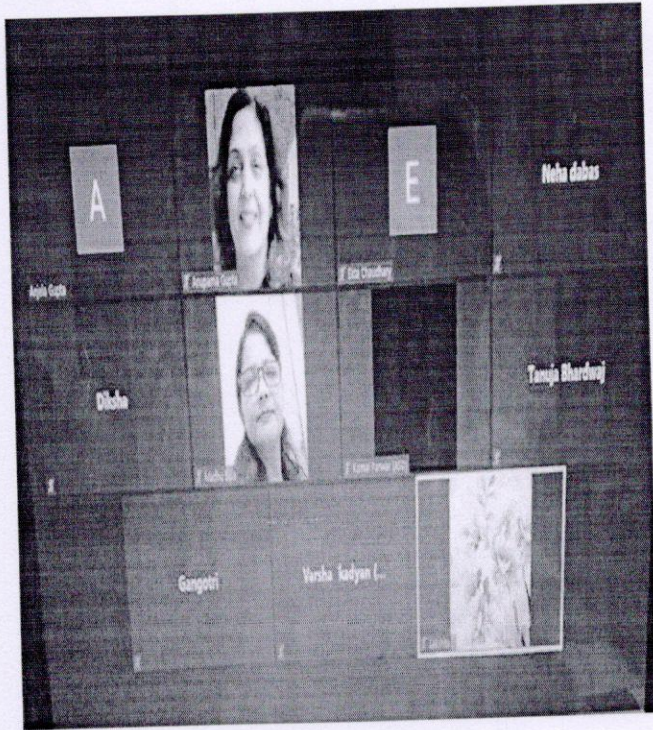
Report of the Event

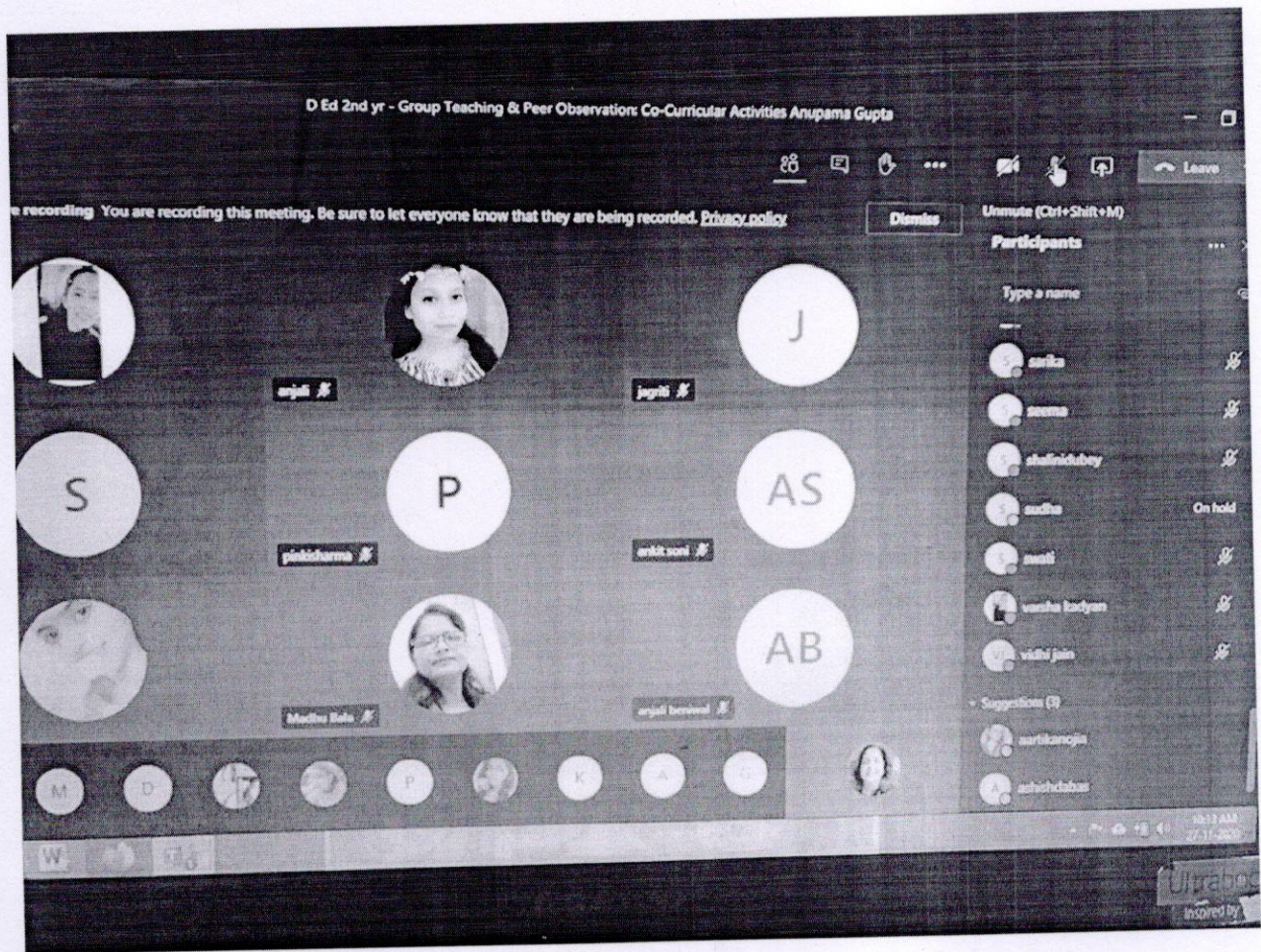
