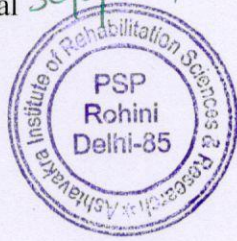

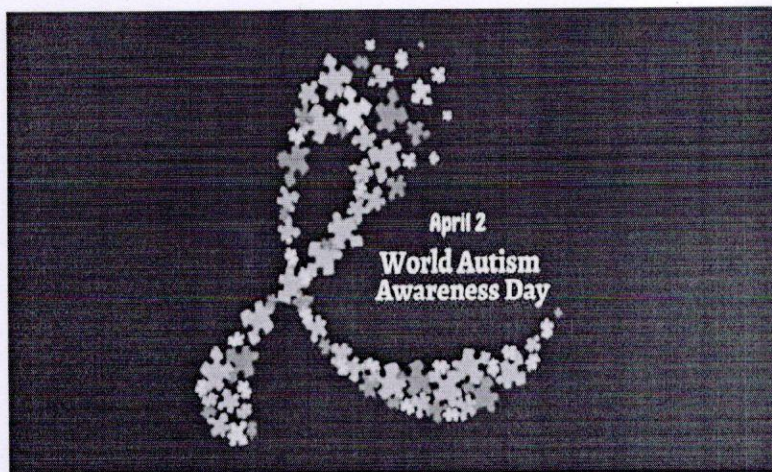

3. To celebrate and reinforce achievements of humanity.



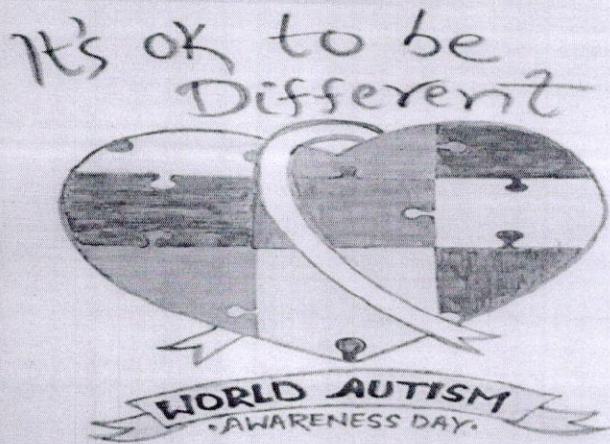
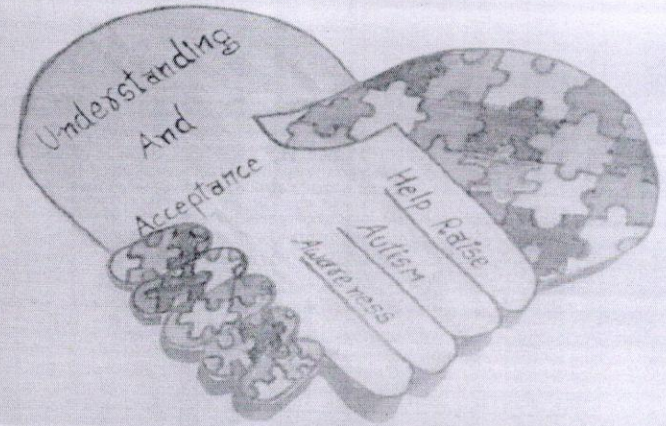
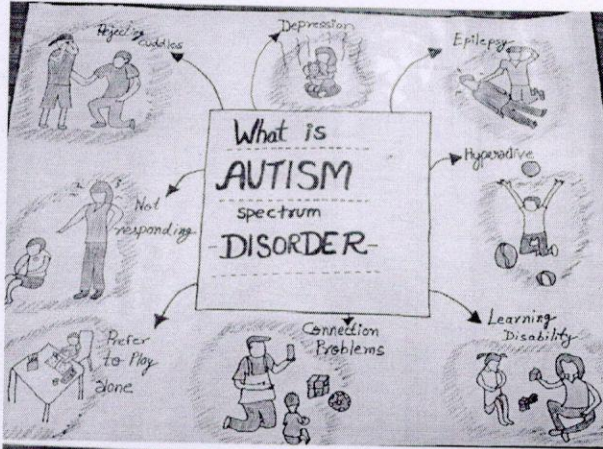
Report of the Event

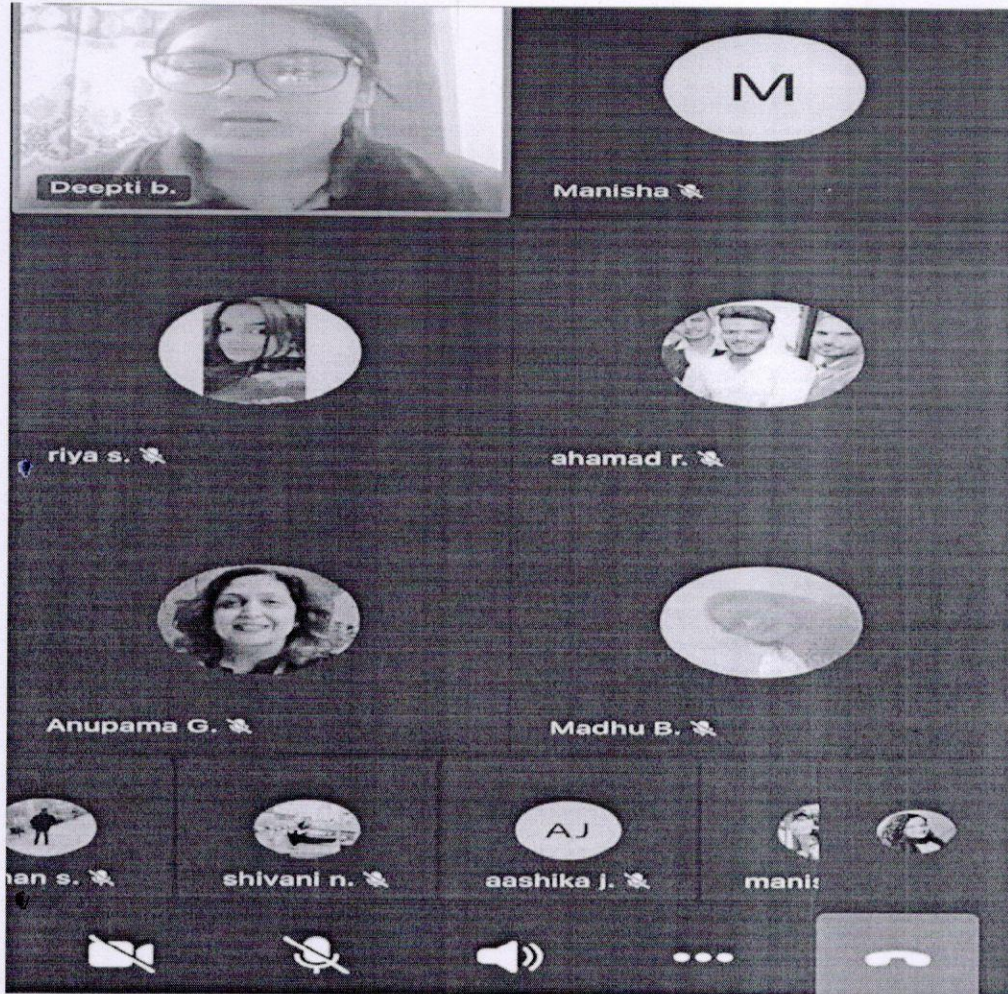

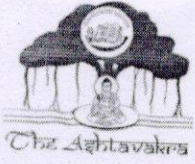
Snapshots of the Event
