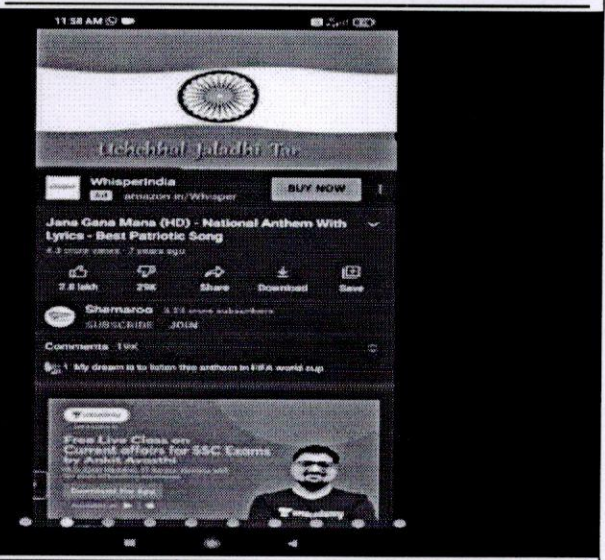
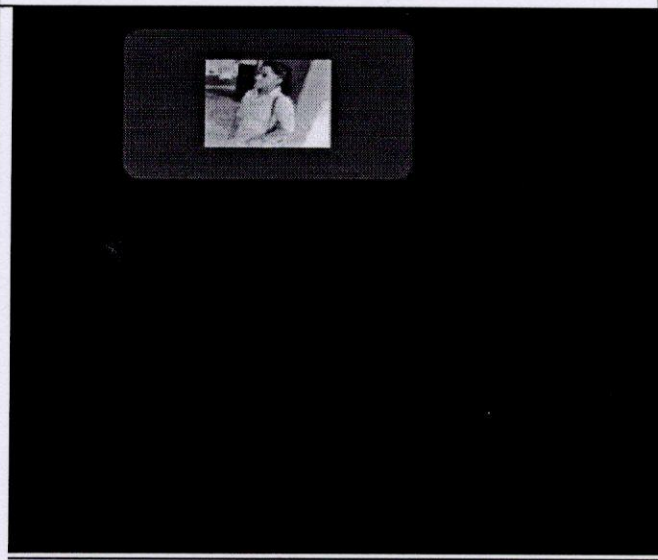
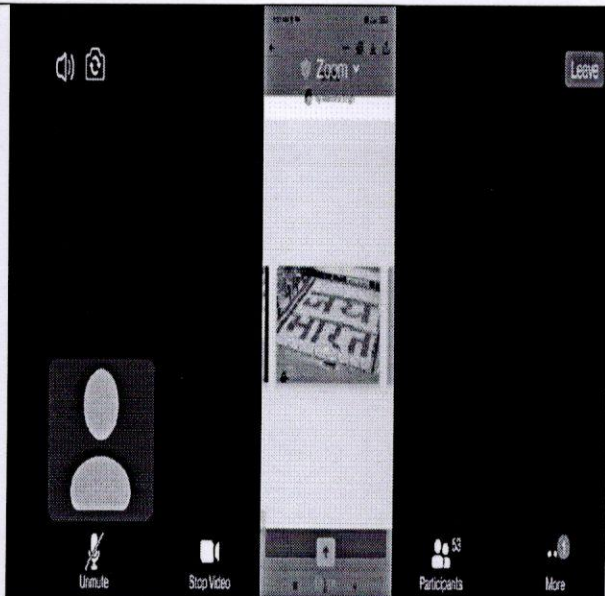


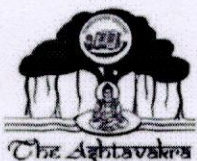
Learning outcomes:
