Objectives of the Training Programme

- To have a basic knowledge of the key areas of child development, educational theory and the computer knowledge with updated software for blind and low vision students.
- To develop competency in a range of teaching skills to suit the needs of the children being taught.
- To correlate theoretical knowledge with real time practice with the special students.

REPORT

All the students and accompanying faculty members assembled at the premises of Ashtavakra Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences and Research and boarded the bus at 5pm PM on 1st April, 2022 and started journey to National Association for Blind, Himachal Pradesh. The bus stopped for the dinner at 9pm for 1 hour. Then again the journey continues to reach the final destination. In the morning the bus stopped at Hill Star Restaurant, Mandi. All students got fresh up and had their breakfast their only. After that we proceed for NAB visit. We reached the center at 11:15 AM. All the students assembled in an open area where the head of the institute welcomed the students and the staff of AIRSR. The resource person Mrs. Shalini Vats gave brief introduction about the services provided by institution and discussed the services available in the institute:

- Computer education for school children
- Braille and large print unit
- Therapy center
- Teaching Learning Materials For Children With Special Needs
- Vocational training

The organization lays special emphasis on education and skill development. NAB aims to send each and every visually impaired child into mainstream school. It highly advocates the concept of integrated education for social fulfillment. Organization works to achieve education for all disabled children, we are in collaboration with National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) to provide opportunity for those students who come late to the education system or have difficulty in continuing regular school. The students of Ashtavakra visited all the areas of the Institute and gained the practical exposure of dealing children with special needs.

Learning outcomes of educational tour:


- The students learnt the idea about the Universal Design Model & Universal Design For Learning.


