Event: - Swachhta Everyone's Business

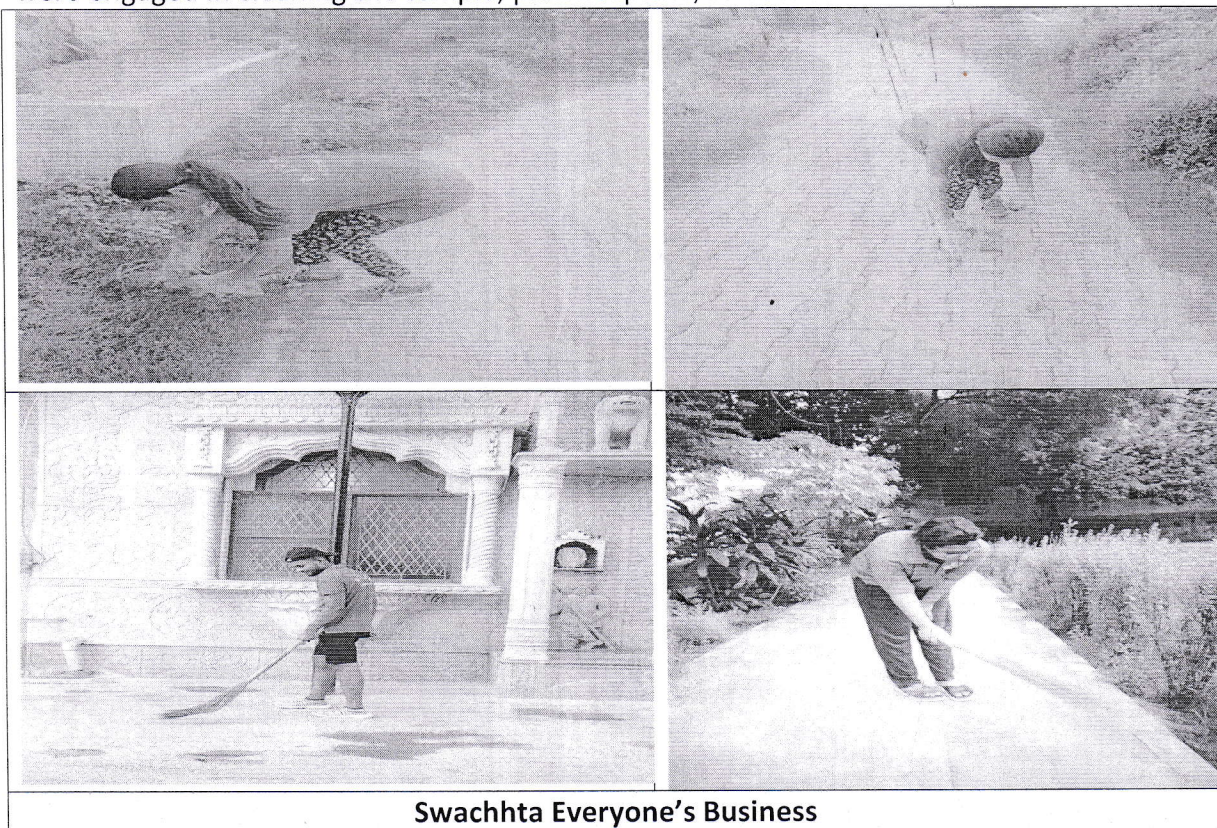

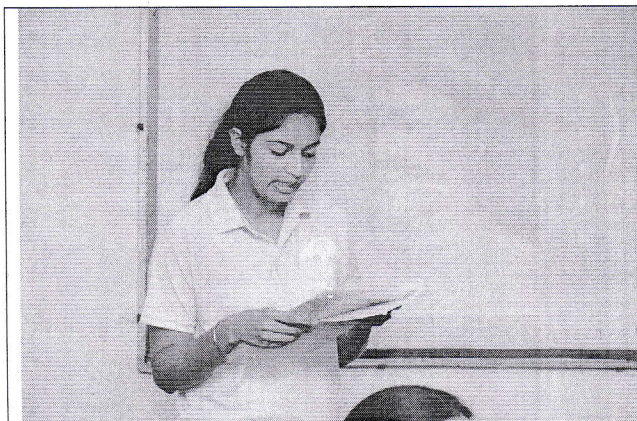
Objective:-

- To pay the tribute to our Unsung Heroines

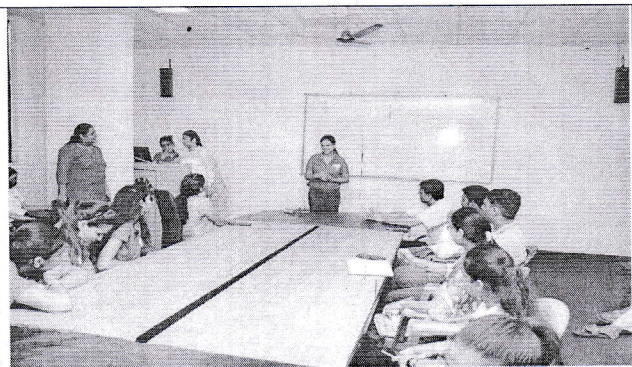
Report:-

Mrs. Sanajana Mittal, Deputy Director in her address said that our freedom fighters fought for more than 300 years against the British to get Independence. She elaborated that government is giving importance on bringing out the contribution of the unsung heroes of freedom struggle as part of celebrations of 75 years of Independence. She said that the history of freedom struggle should be divided into four parts including famous persons, places of freedom struggle, events and unsung heroes. She stressed the importance of documentation in history and many events were not noted in history records leaving them unnoticed. She remembered many unsung heroes like Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Rani Laxmi Bai, Lala Lajpat Rai, etc. She also urged students to remember the sacrifices of freedom fighters who fought hard for India's Independence. In her special address she said Independence was not a celebration for a single day as so many people have fought for many years to get us freedom. She stressed that freedom fighters should be remembered especially by younger generation so that their sacrifices would be honoured.

The Students of Ashtavakra paid their tributes to 'Unsung Heroes' who played an important role in India's freedom movement. They presented biographical sketches and recited powerful stories narratives of our unsung heroes.

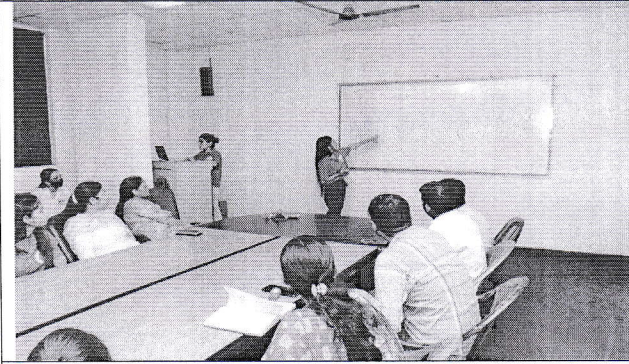

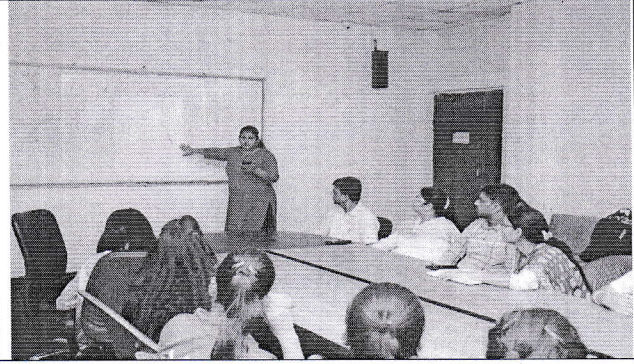

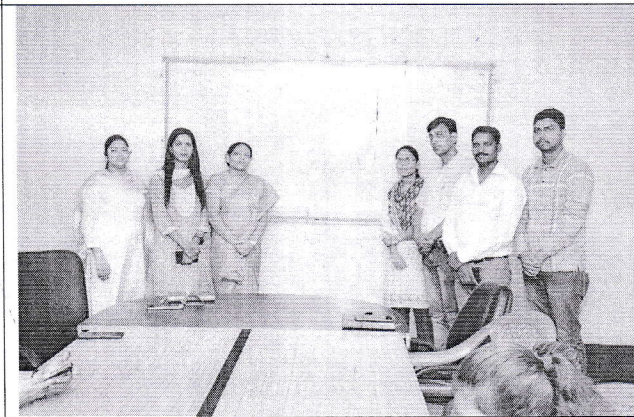

Objective:-

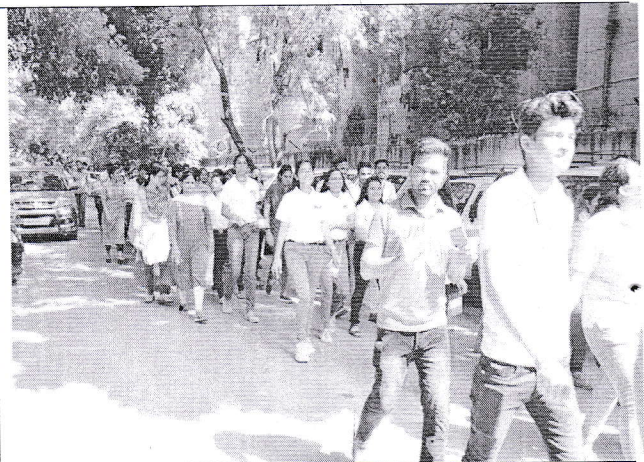
- To encourage people to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark the 75th year of India's independence.

Report:-

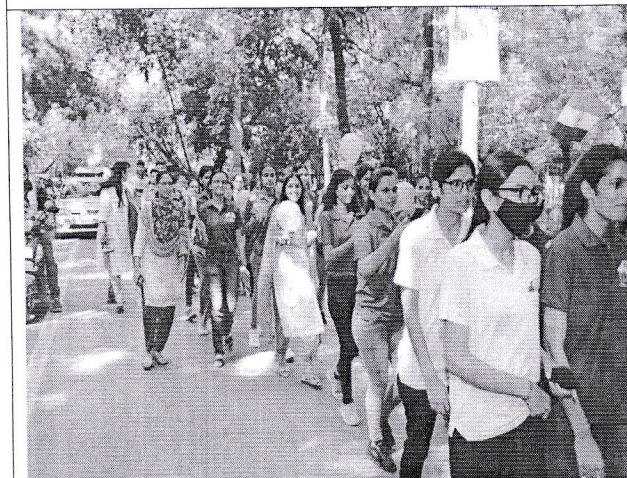

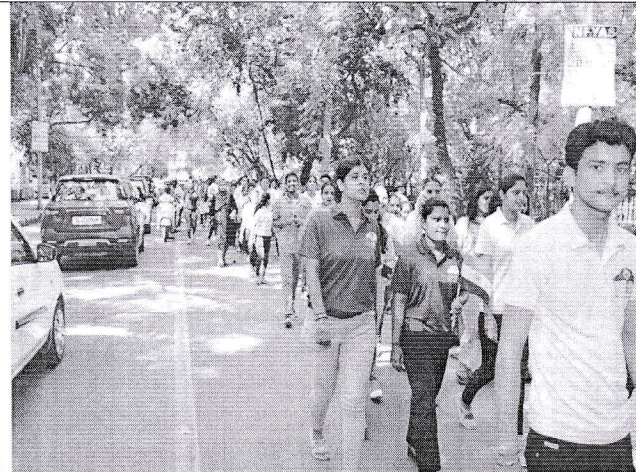

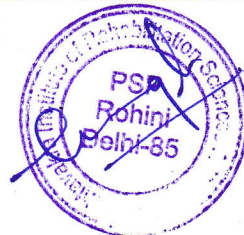

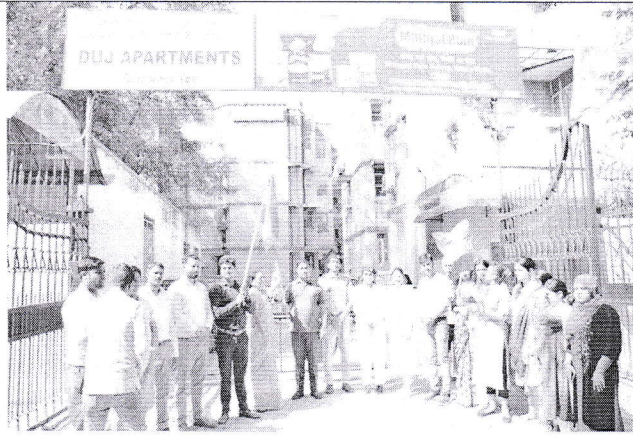

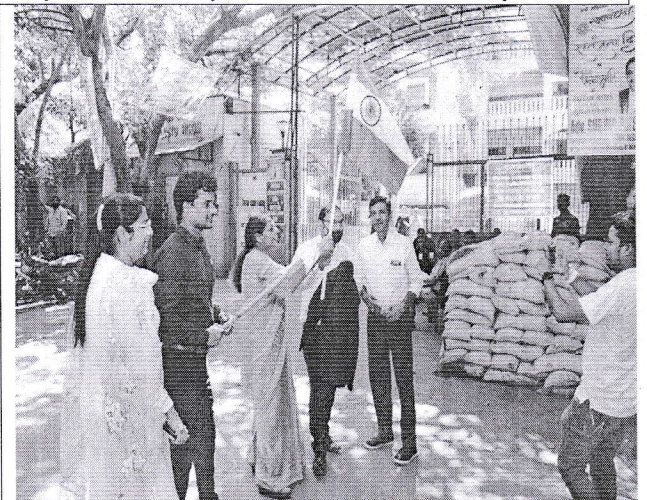

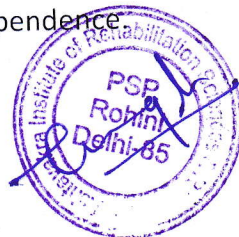
