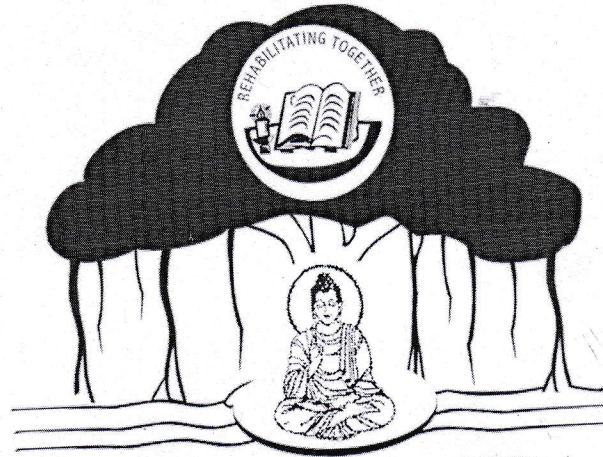

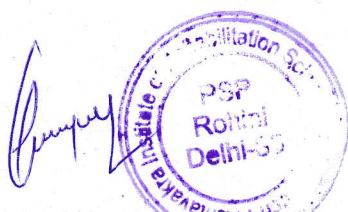

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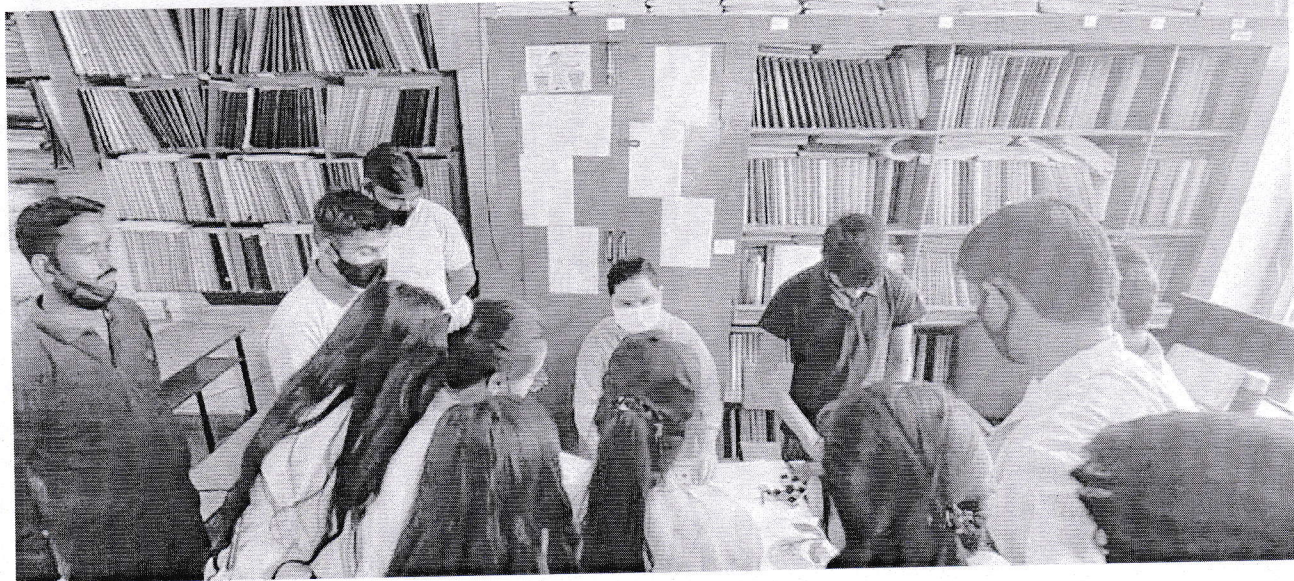

Day 02 : Picnic Spot Camp

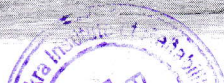
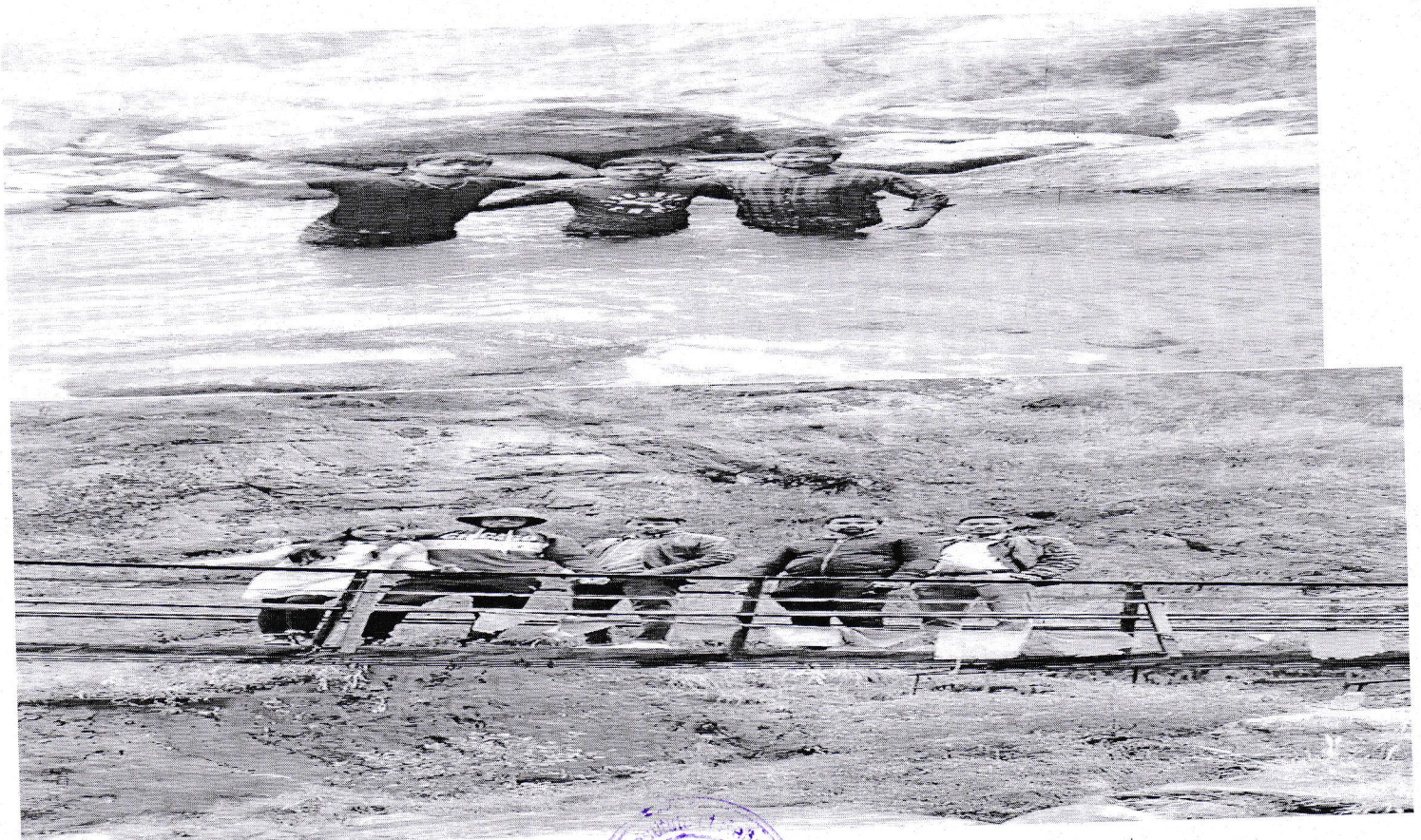




On the third day the students woked up early morning and after breakfast got ready for Water fall and enjoyed tracking
