Learning objectives:

- 1. To spread awareness among students about Community Based Rehabilitation
- 2. To encourage students to understand the Disability at the root level of the society and their associated needs
- 3. To encourage students to prescribe the correct referral services for the welfare of the society
- 4. To encourage students to explain the various institutional and community based services provided by the government to the parents of children with special needs

Report

The students were divided in six groups. Each group had a leader. Each group visited one colony. The students surveyed door to door identifying special need students. As they identified special need students, Ashtavakra students took case history from the parents briefed them about various schemes available for them, explained about provisions provided by the government at the root level and explained the benefits of the disability certificate, provided list of various hospital where they can go for assessment and necessary intervention, gave information about the ADIP scheme to the parents of the children with special needs. Thereafter when all the students returned back to the college, a group discussion was organized where all the students shared their experiences. In all the students were able to identify 15 special students.

Learning outcomes:

- 1. The students were able to understand the real meaning of community based rehabilitation.
- 2. The students were able to provide correct referral services to the parents of children with special needs The students were able to provide one on one guidance to the parents of special children as per their requirement









