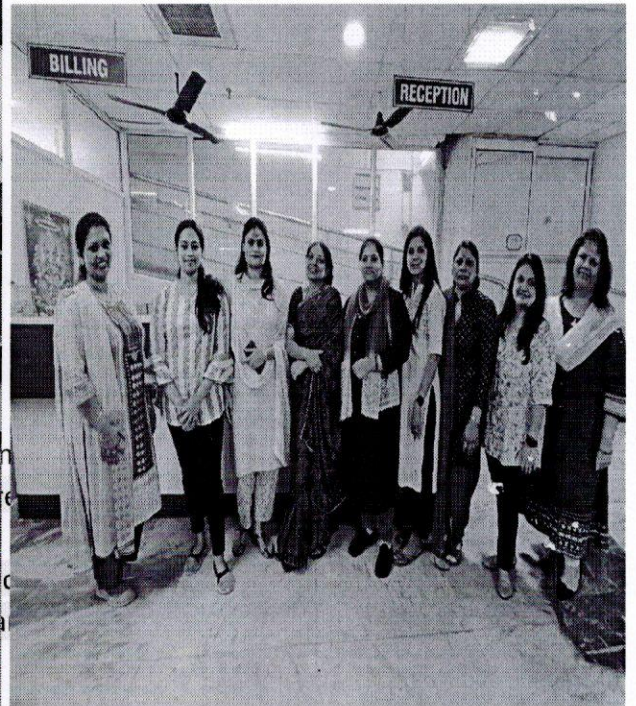
1. To celebrate the colourful and gay festival in harmony.

Report

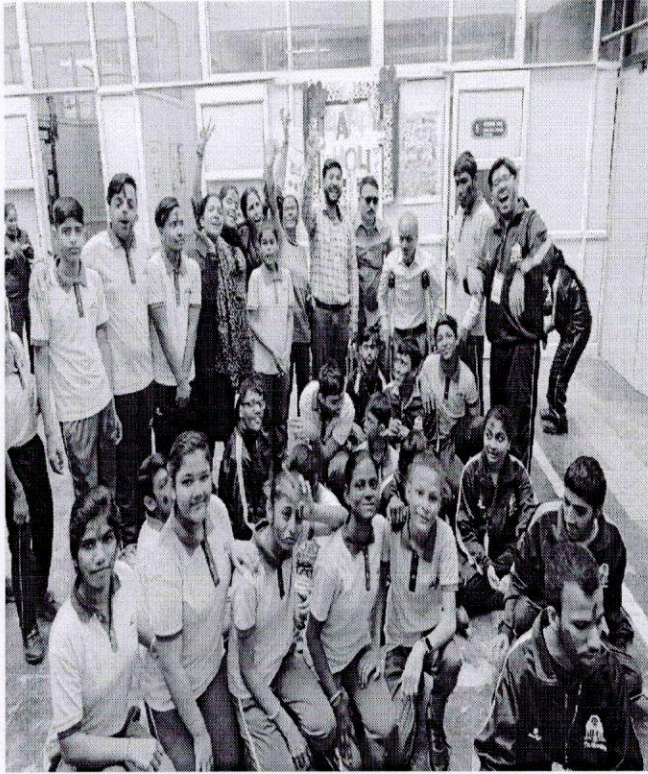
