

Starting from the institute the students marched to 'Saroj Hospital' accusing slogans of 'White Cane Day'. Then at the front of Bagwan Mahavir Hospital some students of VI department performed a Nukkad Natak which helped by passers to get knowledge about blind people and their world of hopes and lights which awarded them that they should make the blind persons independently. There after a small workshop was held under NSS. The cane



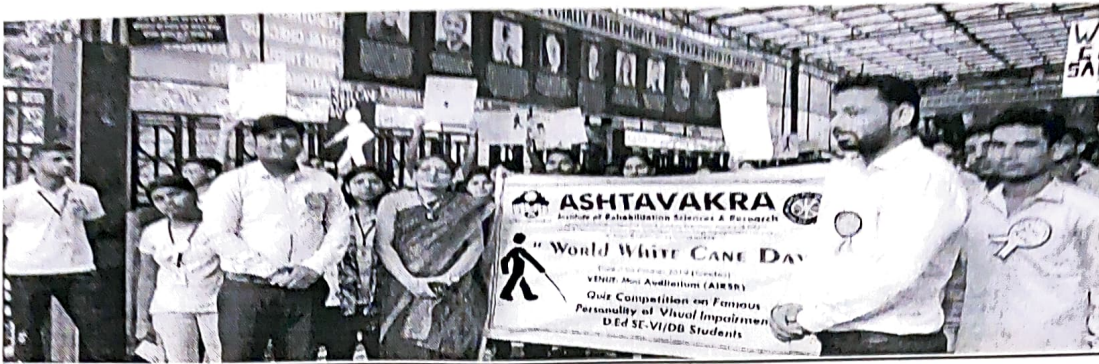
was invented by 'RICHARD EDWIN HOOVER' who was an American teacher of mathematics and physical education at the Maryland school for blind. He invented the cane in 1945 after World War II to support the life of those soldiers who got blind during the war. Focusing on the theme of the day 15 October 2022, an awareness program regarding WHITE CANE SAFETY DAY was held at Ashtavakra Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences & Research, Madhuban Chowk Rohini-85. At last, the aim of this event has both celebrating the White Cane Safety Day and to bring the awareness to those who are not familiar to travelling under the guidance of the White Cane.

Program Outcome

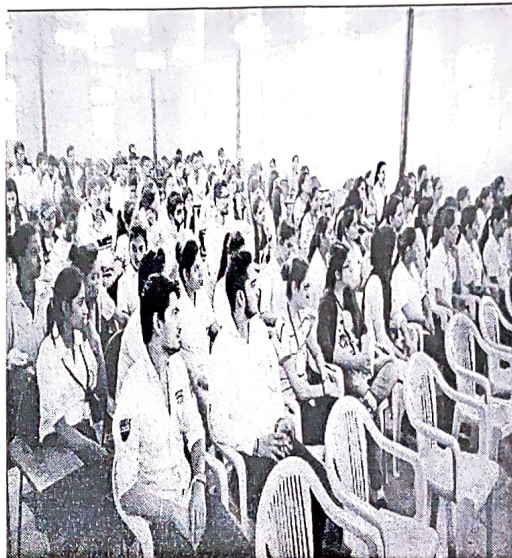
1. All students, faculty and staff member have taken the Pledge whole heartedly for the help of the blind's person.
