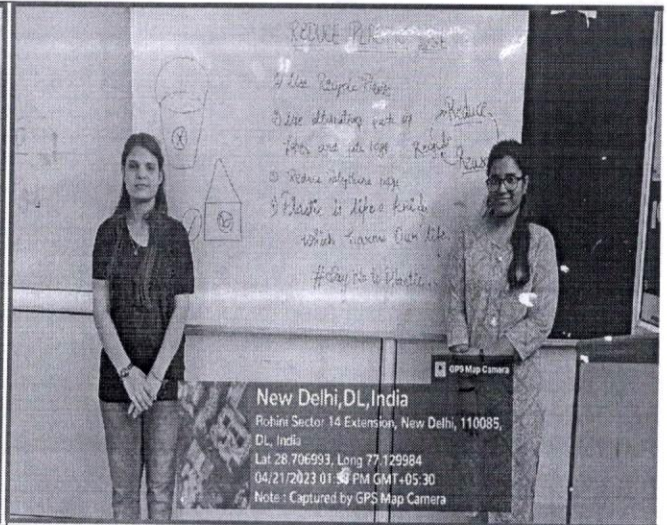

The program started by introductory speech on plastic Pollution by Mr. Sandeep Tiwari ; In-Charge Eco Club in which he expressed his views that Plastic pollution is the accumulation of plastic objects and particles like plastic bottles, bags and micro bead in the Earth's environment that adversely affects humans, wildlife and their habitat. Plastic pollution can afflict land, waterways and oceans. It is estimated that 1.1 to 8.8 million tons of plastic waste enters the ocean from coastal communities each year. It is estimated that there is a stock of 86 million tons of plastic marine debris in the worldwide ocean .There after B.Ed. ASD students Manika, and kriti presented their views on plastic pollution through demonstration: Ms Kriti expressed that how plastic harm our environment she told that plastic pollution is one of the pollution whose effect in our all habitation plastic create in environment Water pollution Air Pollution Soil Pollution etc., along with human impact of plastic pollution is very high on animal, birds and other plants life: "Plastic is a knife which destroy our life" Manika B.Ed. ASD student talked about the high metallic plastic which we use in our day to day life like tooth paste pouch and other cosmetic pouch which is not degradable and adds on to our earth for our next four generations to come .Some other B.Ed. students went to park and created awareness on plastic pollution through display of posters. They highlighted use of alternative means for carrying daily commodities. Every minute one garbage truck of plastic is dumped into the ocean. To Beat Plastic Pollution and mitigate its impacts, we must reduce the production of plastic.

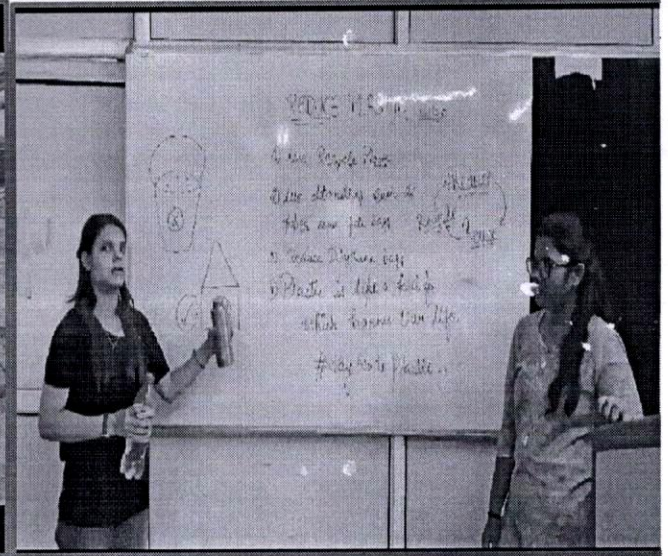
