

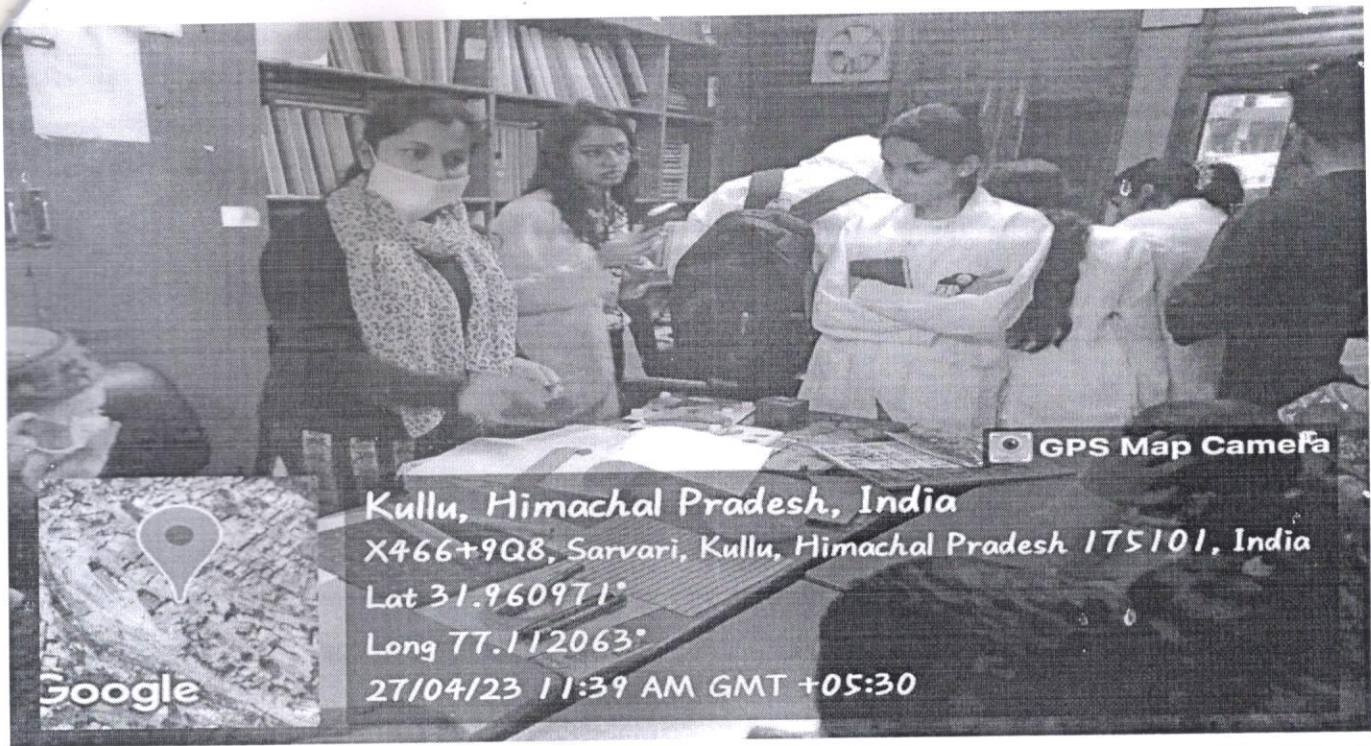
Day 02 NAB Kullu:

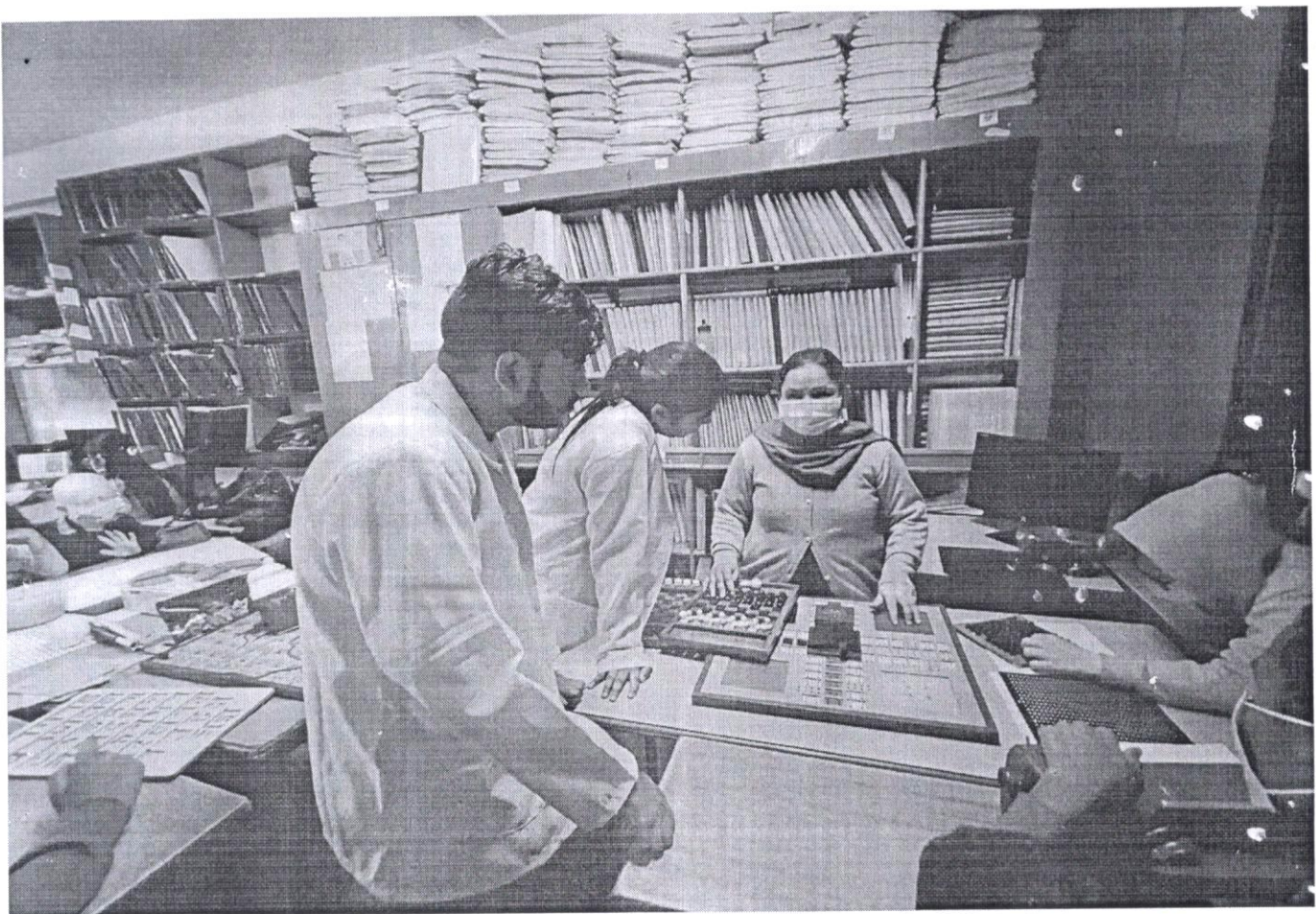


Group photo with Trainee Students at NAB

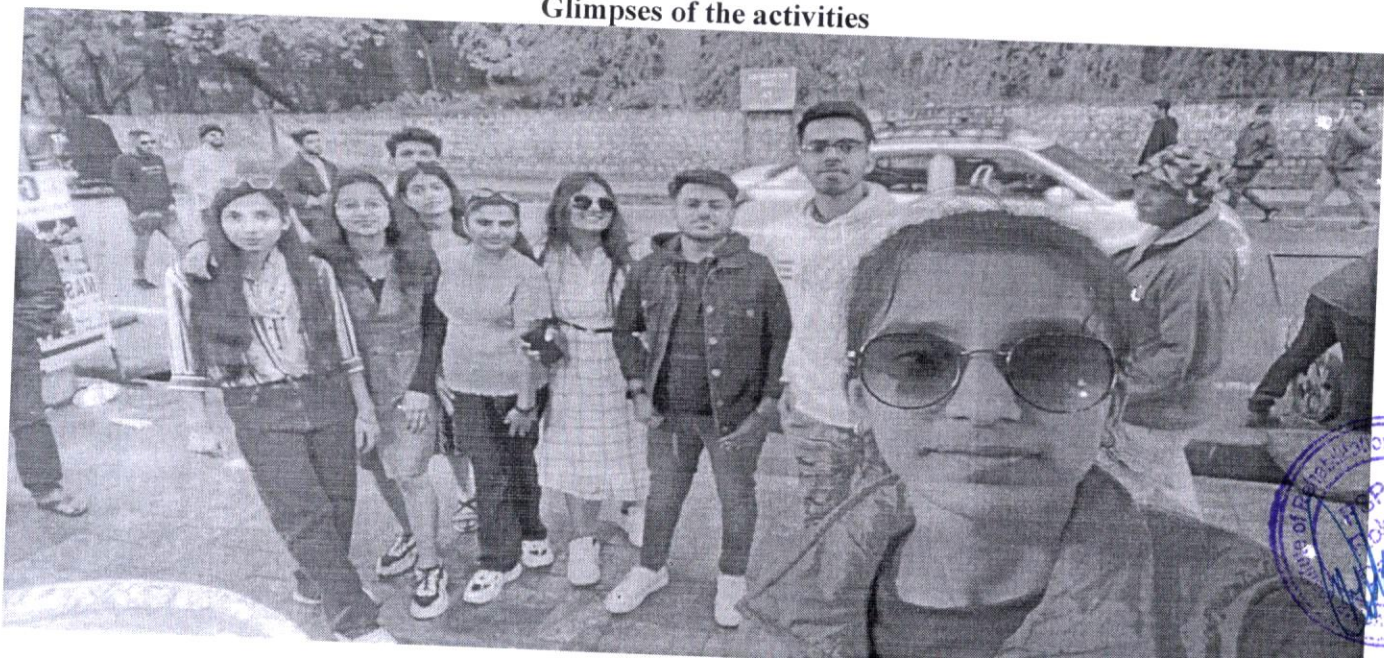
At night the students relished the dinner followed by DJ Night
