

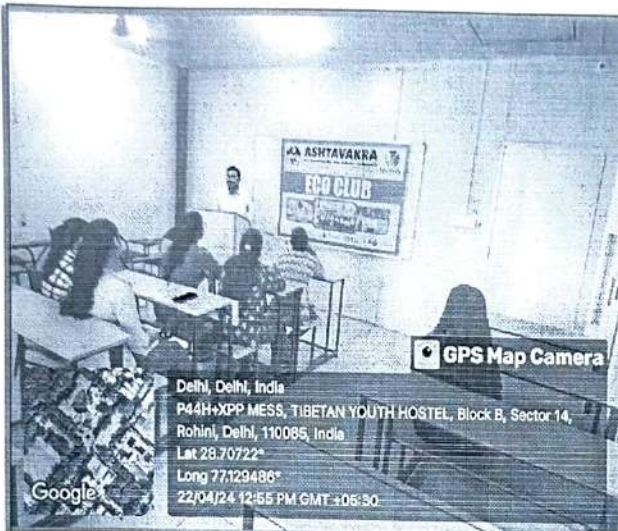
- The students will be able to increase awareness about the importance of Earth an Environment.

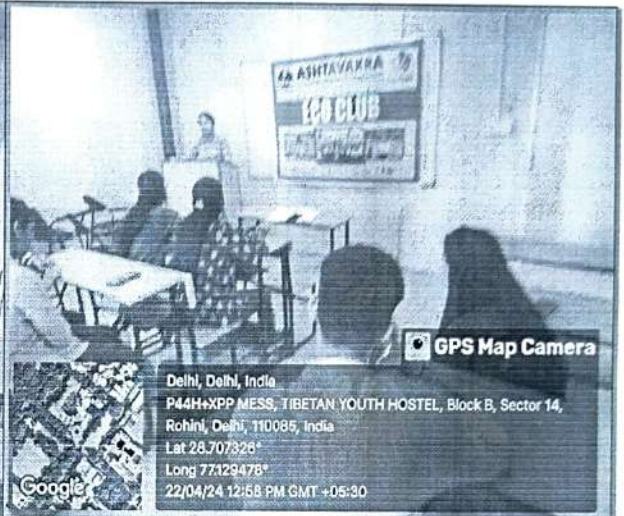

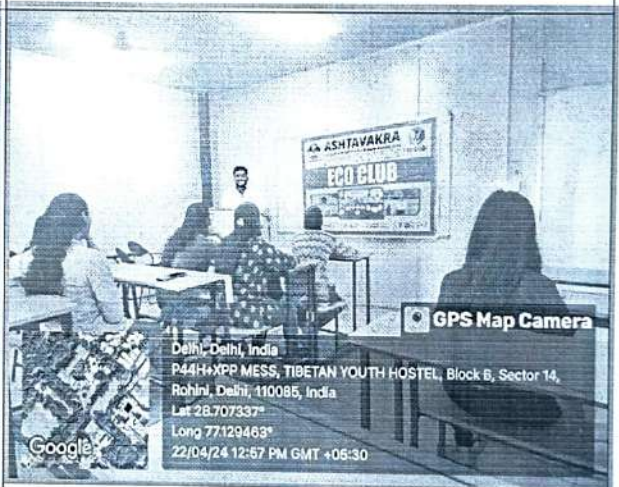
