Report: Description

On 27th September 2024, Ashtavakra Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences and Research organized an educational visit for B. ED SE ID students to Khushboo Welfare Society, in Gurugram. The purpose of the visit was to enhance the students understanding of Educational Objectives and provide them with practical insights into special education.

The chosen destination for the educational visit was Khushboo Welfare Society, in Gurugram. This location was selected due to its relevance to the curriculum and its potential to offer valuable learning experiences.

The main objectives of the visit was following: -

To supplement classroom learning with real-world examples and applications.

To expose students to clinical facilities related to their academic studies.

To promote interactive learning and foster a deeper understanding of class observation and clinical setup

Educational visit was under the supervision of the Mr. Tarun Pataanjali (Assistant Professor). He facilitated the students in the visit by highlighting them the importance of school visits which further followed up to visiting each class and clinical facilities of the Institute. Khushboo Welfare Society (KWS) was established on 13 November 1995 as a nonprofit organization under the Societies Act, 1860 to provide holistic care and multifarious

services to people with mental and multiple disabilities. Its objectives is to help the physically and mentally challenged to become self-reliant, realize their full potential and enhance their capabilities to the maximum possible. Students were further guided by the Dr. Lalit (Occupational Therapist) about the clinical facilities and how the institute works in the rehabilitation of the Intellectual disabled children.

In this visit student visited classroom of children with intellectual disabilities and they also visited In Occupational therapy room, Physio therapy room, Sensory Integration therapy room, Speech and Audiology room, Computer lab, Kitchen and vocational training room were explained by Ms. Shashi. The students experienced and observed how different assessment were performed on the children. The centre delivers it services through two programs comprising of various activities and the schedule is based on the child's individual development plan.
