Report of the Event

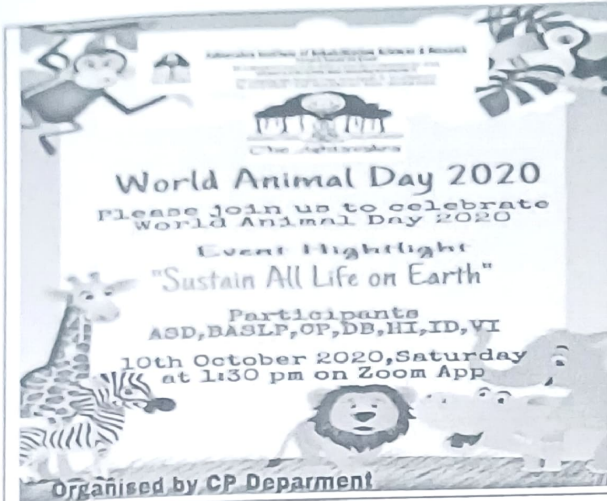

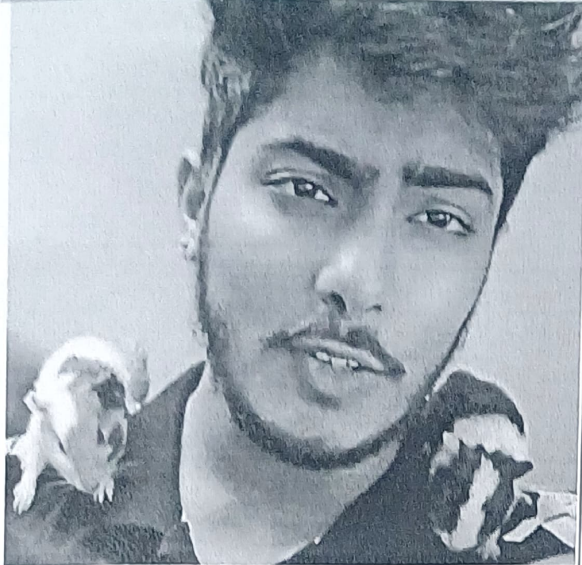

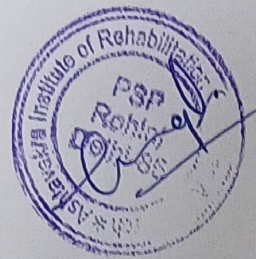
