

On 16 May 2025, a comprehensive dengue awareness activity was organized to educate students and staff about the prevention and control of dengue fever. The event began with an informative session highlighting the causes, symptoms, and dangers of dengue, emphasizing the importance of early detection and timely medical intervention. Participants learned about the life cycle of the Aedes mosquito, the primary vector for dengue, and the critical role of eliminating stagnant water to prevent mosquito breeding.

As part of the activity, students and volunteers conducted a campus cleanliness drive, inspecting various areas for potential mosquito breeding sites. They removed stagnant water, cleaned surroundings, and sprinkled disinfectants in vulnerable spots, following safe and environmentally friendly practices. Informative posters and pamphlets were distributed, and interactive discussions were held to reinforce key preventive measures such as using mosquito nets, wearing protective clothing, and maintaining personal and community hygiene.

The activity not only increased awareness but also fostered a sense of responsibility and community participation among all involved. By the end of the programme, participants were better equipped with practical knowledge and motivated to act as ambassadors for dengue prevention in their homes and neighbourhoods, contributing to a healthier and safer environment for all.
