On 2nd July 2025, Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi became the epicenter of national attention as it hosted a high-profile celebration and public exhibition marking the first anniversary of India's new criminal laws. The event, organized by the Delhi Police and attended by senior government officials, legal professionals, students, and the general public, aimed to raise awareness about the transformative impact of these laws on the country's criminal justice system. Union Home Minister Amit Shah, addressing the gathering, described the enactment of these laws as the "biggest reform in independent India," emphasizing their role in protecting citizens' rights while ensuring no criminal escapes justice. He highlighted that since July 2024, all new FIRs have been registered under the BNS and that the system now prioritizes justice delivery over mere penal action.
