



The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) Club of Ashtavakra Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences and Research organized an E-Shram Camp on 11th November 2025 with the objective of creating awareness and facilitating registration of unorganized sector workers under the Government of India's E-Shram initiative.

The camp was conducted with active participation of students and faculty coordinators as part of the institute's commitment towards community outreach and rural development. The primary aim of the activity was to support workers such as daily wage labourers, construction workers, domestic helpers, street vendors, and other unorganized sector employees by helping them enroll on the E-Shram portal and understand the benefits associated with it.

During the camp, students assisted beneficiaries in the registration process by collecting basic details, verifying documents, and guiding them through the online system. Awareness was also created about the advantages of E-Shram registration, including access to social security schemes, insurance coverage, and future welfare benefits. The interaction with workers helped students gain insights into the socio-economic conditions and


