


<p>Report: Description in (min 250 to max 800 words)*</p>	<p>Swami Vivekananda, born Narendranath Datta on January 12, 1863, in Kolkata, transformed into a global spiritual icon through his profound interpretations of Vedanta and Yoga. His electrifying speech at the 1893 Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago introduced Hinduism to the West, emphasizing universal tolerance with the words, "I am proud to belong to a religion which has taught the world both tolerance and universal acceptance." Vivekananda's teachings focused on youth empowerment, declaring, "Arise, awake, and stop not till the goal is reached," from the Katha Upanishad. The government's decision to dedicate his birthday to youth stemmed from his belief in their role as nation-builders, announced by Prime Minister Indira Gandhi to instill moral and patriotic values amid India's youthful demographic boom.</p>
